APPEAL UNDER RULE 48(7) OF THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT RULES, 2004


The Authority received an Appeal filed by M/s Technoflux (Pvt) Ltd., through its authorized representative Mr. Nabeel Sajid "the Appellant" on 07.04.2026 under Rule 48(7) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2004. The Authority on receipt of the Appeal issued notices to M/s Technoflux (Pvt) Ltd., through its authorized representative Mr. Nabeel Sajid ("Appellant"); Federal Government Employees Housing Authority (FGEHA), through its Deputy Director (Water Supply / Maintenance), Islamabad; Federal Government Employees Housing Authority (FGEHA), through its Grievance Redressal Committee, Islamabad, wherein it was directed to appear in person or through their nominated representatives or Counsel before the Authority on 28-04-2026 before the Appellate Committee in the Committee Room of Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA).

2. The present appeal was filed by M/s Techno flux (Pvt) Ltd. against the Federal Government Employees Housing Authority (FGEHA) on 07-04-2026 and was registered as Appeal No. PPRA/AP-19/2026. The Authority has received a written request dated 27-04-2026 submitted by the Appellant (Techno flux Private Limited), whereby the Appellant has sought withdrawal of the above-captioned appeal. In its request, the Appellant has stated that no further proceedings have been undertaken in the matter and we no longer wish to pursue the case. The Appellant has further clarified that the withdrawal is voluntary and without prejudice.

3. In view of the above request and as no objection to the withdrawal has been placed on record, the Appellate Committee finds no impediment in acceding to the Appellant's request. Accordingly, Appeal No. PPRA/AP-16/2026 is hereby **dismissed as withdrawn**. The case file is ordered to be closed.
